Excellent Attendance expected at Hazlewood Community Primary School

Hazlewood Community Primary School is committed to the continuous raising of achievement of all our pupils. Regular attendance is critical if our pupils are to be successful and benefit from the opportunities presented to them.

Only the Headteacher can authorise absence for approved reasons. Schools have discretion to allow absence in term time for special circumstances such as:

For service personnel and other employees who are prevented from taking holidays outside term-time if the holiday will have minimal disruption to the pupil's education.

When a family needs to spend time together to support each other during or after a crisis, such as death or terminal illness of a person close to the family.

For attendance at a funeral.

For attendance at a wedding of a close family member.

All absences other than for illness should be submitted to the school office, in writing, prior to the date.
