Mathematics:

The children will consolidate prior learning to ensure key skills are secured such as place value, counting in 2's, 5's and 10's; adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers, numbers bonds up to 20; time and shape. As well as this they will look at position and direction working together as a team to move through a maze.

Computing:

In this computing topic we will be using technology to help us explore our local area. It uses investigative tasks to introduce children to the idea of looking at their local area with the aid of technology. The local area will be studied frequently during a child's time in primary school and therefore this unit focuses on aspects of local features to support learning about directional language and 3D skills to build amazing structures.

Geography/History:

We will look at our local area particularly the coastline and will learn about castles. We hope to enhance our topic by visiting Alnwick castle.

Science:

Linking our Geography, Maths and ICT topics together; science will look at the children working together to design, build and test out a model such as a bridge or draw bridge. The children

English:

Children will continue to develop their phonological understanding as well as knowledge of high frequency words and common exception words.

We will focus on reading using phonics as well as increasing fluency.

Art, Design and Technology:

The children will be creating castle art using different techniques.

Music:

The children will learn a number of songs and will perform this at the Whitley Bay Playhouse.

PE: The children will continue to develop their physical skills in a range of activities provided by professional coaches.
