Prime Areas

Communication and Language:

- Role Play area- Home Corner.
- Rhyme times/learning rhymes.
- Sharing SST interests with class/ small group
- Pre –reading skills – sequencing, predicting.
- Re-telling favourite stories with puppets/small world figures.
- Listening skills as part of a group.
- Continuation of Over and Over scheme in small groups.

Personal, Social and Emotional:

- Settling in and establishing rules and routines
- Feeling secure/safe- introducing Colour Monster story to focus on different emotions and feelings.
- Circle times to encourage turn taking and Sharing.
- Respecting others and the environment around us.
- Specific focus on being proud of ourselves and those around us.

Physical Development

- Outdoor learning time to develop gross and fine motor skills as well as in response to interests.
- Circle games-Indoor & out.
- Focus on pre-literacy skills to strengthen hands such as dough disco.
- Forest School opportunities on a fortnightly basis.
- Access Coaching- specific focus on spacial awareness
- Go noodle and cosmic kids yoga opportunities.

Literacy: Sustained Shared Thinking approach

Writing:

- initial sounds, CVC words (Autumn 1)
- CVC words, captions and simple sentence writing (Autumn 2)
- Finger spaces for those that are ready
- Name writing

Reading:

- Weekly guided/independent reading
- Encourage reading area for independent free choice
- A range of fact and fiction stories to be used during SST approach to develop knowledge further.

Maths:

- Subitising to develop number sense and number recognition- numicon matching.
- Developing number sense through 'number of the week'
- Making 5/10 in a range of ways- simple addition
- Ordering numbers to 10
- One more than/One less than
- Number songs for counting forwards and backwards
- 2D shapes
