## Year 2

### Summer 2022

#### **Mathematics:**

This term, we will be developing our knowledge around various measurement topics including time, mass, length and height, as well as geometry topics such as position and direction. We will continue to develop our reasoning and problem solving skills, as well as continue to revise our fluency skills, focussing on the four main operations and fractions. The children will continue to develop and challenge themselves further with their times tables too.

#### **History & Geography:**

In geography, we will be learning all about the continents and oceans of the world, alongside countries and capitals, compass directions and human/physical features. In history, we will be learning about what life would have been like living in a castle, and some of the key castle roles, including Kings and Queens.

#### **Science:**

This term, we will develop our understanding of plants. We will learn about the different needs of plants and what they require in order to survive, as well as the lifecycle of a plant. We will also explore various types of plants including those that we can consume, and take a detailed look at certain parts of plants including their seeds. To further our learning and strengthen our skills around thinking scientifically, we will also conduct our own class cress experiment.

#### **RE:**

This term we will be learning all about Islam, and the key aspects, symbols and celebrations associated with this religion. We will also be exploring Buddhism and how Buddhists show their beliefs.

#### **PSHCE:**

This term we will be exploring the topics of citizenship and then economic wellbeing. We will be learning about the importance of rules, roles within the community and ways to share opinions. Topics such as jobs, money and needs and wants will also be explored.

#### **English:**

This half term we will be continuing to develop our fictional writing through the retelling of various traditional tales. We will also be developing our non-fiction writing, focusing on a recount with a link to our castle topic, as well as our poetry writing with a theme of kindness and friendship. The children will be developing their grammatical understanding, with a focus on tenses, similes, speech and sentence forms. We will also continue focused handwriting lessons. In relation to reading, we will be continuing to develop our reading comprehension and phonics skills daily, as well as accessing Accelerated Reader and now Myon.

#### **Computing:**

This term in computing, we will be developing our coding skills and learning around digital sound.

#### **Art & Design and Technology:**

In art, we will be studying the human form and creating artwork such as Opie style portraits, clothes peg figures and sculptures. We will then be moving onto learning new mixed media skills, with a focus on superheroes.

#### **Music:**

We will be learning and rehearsing two songs ahead of the showcase performance later on in the term.
