Mathematics

To read, write, order and compare numbers up to 1,000,000 and determine the value of each digit

To round any whole number to a required degree of accuracy

To use negative numbers in context, and calculate intervals across 0

To multiply multi-digit numbers up to 4 digits by a two-digit whole number using the formal written method of long multiplication

To divide numbers up to 4 digits by a one-digit whole number using the formal written method of short division.

Problems solving involving all of these concepts.

History: Ancient Greece

To investigate the legacy of Ancient Greece via primary and secondary sources.

Geography — The Grand Canyon

To locate the Grand Canyon and identify key features (physical and human).

SCIENCE – Animals including Humans

To describe the changes as humans develop to old age.

To explain that some changes result in the formation of new materials, and that this kind of change is not usually reversible. Discuss when materials change and it can be reversed.
