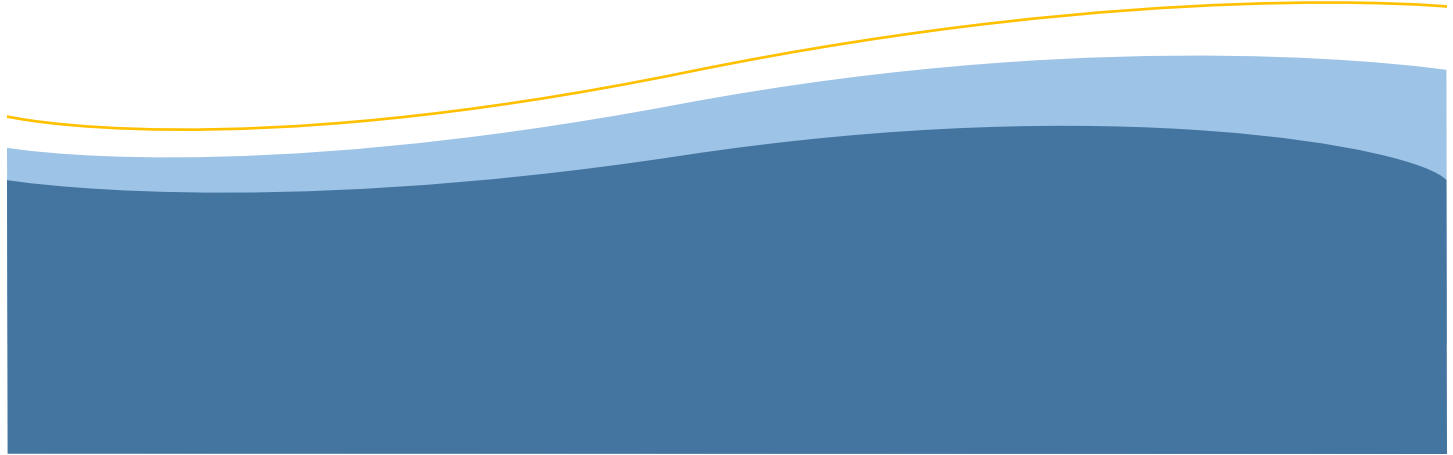

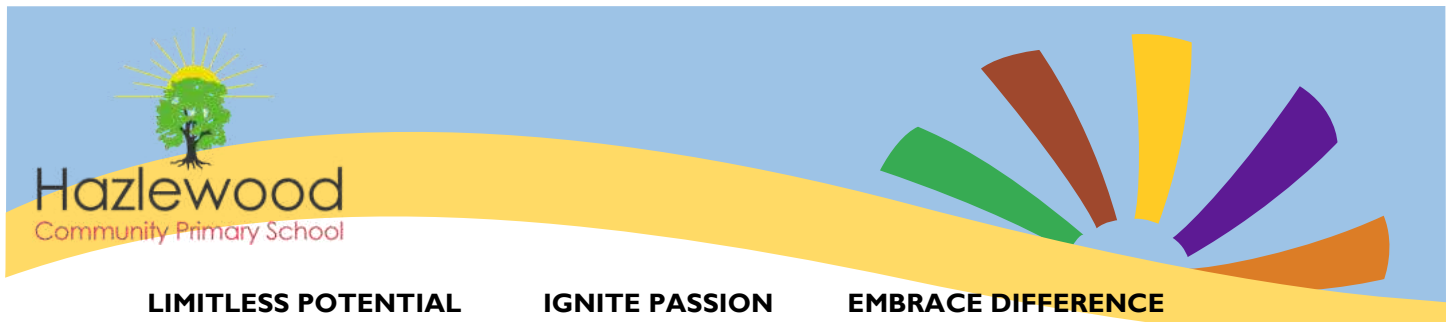
Year 1 Educational Visit to Alnwick Castle

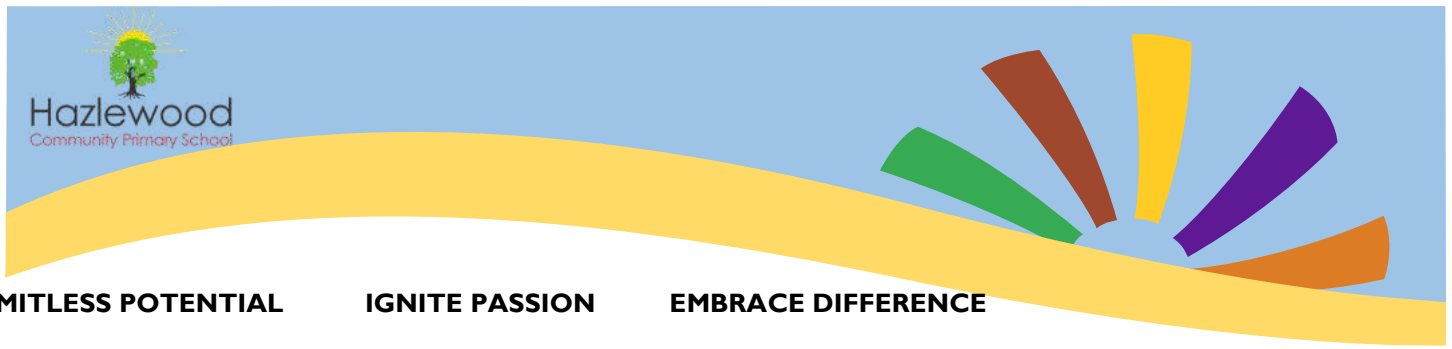
