Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to sincerely thank all the children, our team, our parents, our families St John's Church, our governors and our volunteers for supporting our Remembrance Services this year.

The importance of teaching our children the meaning of Remembrance cannot be ignored. Remembrance Day marks the end of World War I at 11 am on 11th November 1918. It is a day to remember those who served and are currently serving. It is a day when we remember those who have been lost to us in service and to respect their memories. In short, it is a day to remember, to keep memories alive and to hope and pray for a peaceful future. Our future leaders are our children, and in learning about Remembrance, we hope they will both understand the past and work to shape a peaceful future.

On Friday 8th November and on 11th of November, we came together as school community from youngest to oldest, for two special remembrance Services that guided our children through the concept of Remembrance. We talked about service roles and what it means to be in service, about the qualities of people in service and the concept of 'selflessness'.

We share the stories of people in service and why it is important to remember them – to say thank you to those who serve/served, to remember the risks they take and to remember that people who serve are keeping us safe.

We observed two minutes silence whilst listening the bugle call. We ensured there were opportunities for our children to share their thoughts, feelings and any questions they may have. And we hope that, through this annual gathering, the British Values are once again reinforced, and our children have an opportunity to apply them, learning something new and to reflect upon their learning.

Now Headmaster of Haven Nook school, a special school for secondary age children with autism.





To those of us born after the war, the very gift of life.


I cried to see so many, fallen in their prime,
